**Jae Hwan Oh is a former Director of National Cancer Center Hospital, Korea and Adjunct Professor of Department of Cancer Control and Population Health, the NCC-Graduate School of Cancer Science and Policy. Dr. Oh acquired his M.D. from Seoul National University, Korea and Ph.D. from Yonsei University, Korea. His main interests are minimally invasive surgery including transanal TME, organ preserving management for rectal cancer and surgical treatment for oligometastasis of colorectal cancer.**



**His main paper is the “Open versus laparoscopic surgery for mid-rectal or low-rectal cancer after neoadjuvant chemoradiotherapy (COREAN trial); survival outcomes of open-label, non-inferiority, randomised controlled trial” published in Lancet Oncology as a corresponding author that laparoscopic resection for locally advanced rectal cancer after preoperative chemoradiotherapy provides similar outcomes for disease-free survival as open resection.**
